

Drawing 1 Supplies

Since you have already had Art 1, you will probably already have most of these. You can find some of these at Wal-Mart, Staples and all at Hobby Lobby

No.2 pencils (not mechanical)

1 pocket folder for notes and handouts (please keep all handouts)

1 16" x 20" Newsprint Paper Pad OR Large sketchbook will work instead if you cannot get the Newsprint pad. Either one will work to turn in your daily drawing works all together in one connected pad.

Eraser---1 Plastic (white) (sometimes they are called drafting erasers)

1 'Hot Press' (smooth) *Illustration board* or *Drawing Bristol Paper*—size—12 x 18 or approximately that size –does not have to be exact size. Some are 15" x 20" but they don't have to be that large. ('Hot Press' surface—meaning *very smooth surface*)

1 Roll of masking tape

1 Sharpie (black, ultra fine tip)

1 Very Fine tip marker-- Pigma Micron-black (Hobby Lobby) size 005 or 1.0

3 Prismacolor Colored Pencils: 1 black, 1 white and 1 colored (your choice---such as Tuscan Red or Blue Violet, Indigo Blue, Dark Green.)

1 Ball point Ink Pen such as *Bic Atlantis—Fine or Ultra Fine*

You will bring in photos that you have taken or use some from magazines, for practice and assignments. We also work from observation.

Other items that you might get, for your own use in class, but not required).

- 1. Portfolio or paper portfolio** (something to carry work home to work on)
- 2. Soft Pastel or Pastel pencil set**
- 3. 1 kneadable eraser** (the moldable kind that reminds you of 'Silly Putty')
- 4. 1 small hand held pencil sharpener** (to use with colored pencils)
- 5. Set of colored Pencils** (with more variety than the 3 you use for project #1)
- 6. Colorless Blender Pencil**
- 7. Colorless Blender Marker**
- 8. Color Pastel set**
- 9. 1 Toned piece of Paper—Neutral tones (browns, tans, cream, gray, gray-blue)...**
(One side is smooth and the other has a very slight texture) located in the back of Hobby Lobby store.
