## **Art 1 Supply List- Semester 1 (Talley)**

- \*No. 2 pencils (use throughout year-keep in book bag) \*1 Eraser
- \*1 Pocket folder to keep grading rubrics and project handouts)
- \*1 Thin sketchbook (approx. 10" x 14" or in that size range) or one that you used in Junior High art class (you don't have to get a new one if pages left over). You may also get a 16" x 20" newsprint pad at Hobby Lobby in place of sketchbook (don't need both sketchbook and newsprint pad). And, you don't need the largest size that they have.
- \*1 Ultra Fine Sharpie Marker

\*1 sponge

- \*1 piece white poster board
- \*1 roll masking tape
- \*2-3 large zip-lock baggies (gallon size or larger) for airtight paint storage
- \*2 Styrofoam plates (disposable) or a palette (for paint mixing)
- \*1 canvas (can be a stretched canvas or a canvas board) or illustration board (either one-but you don't need both canvas and illustration board (approx. 16" x 20")
- \*1 thick Black marker
- \*A shoebox or plastic container to store your own supplies in. This comes in very handy as you take paints home to work on assignments, for example. Also, it will keep your things separate from the school supplies.

Extra items that you may want of your own but not required: \*Watercolor paint set –if you would rather have your own and not use the school sets that 150 students use per semester) \*1 box of Colored Pencils

\*Paint brushes –small 'rounds' (meaning, not a flat brush) –you may want a couple of your own to use at home. \* Plastic gloves to protect/ keep your hands/nails clean during printmaking.

\*You may use my paint aprons to cover your clothing during a printing day, but you may want to bring your own to cover your clothes.

## Semester 2 –Talley

- \*1 large plastic bag for storing wet clay projects (like a Walmart bag or other store bag-as long as it doesn't have holes). Do not use an old bread bag because the leftover crumbs become moldy and stick to clay.
- \*½ sheet of colored mat board (can be scrap). I can explain the color connection between that and the yarn at a later time).
- \*Yarn-2- 3 colors /partial skeins (ask to see if family members have leftover yarn). Scrap fabric.
- \*Masking tape, old newspapers, \*throw-away /disposable container for plaster.
- \*Sandpaper \* mask --for when using sandpaper

**Extras:** \*Bendable wire (more info. on sculpture projects coming at a later time, so you can wait on the 2<sup>nd</sup> semester items.) Many supply items, 2<sup>nd</sup> semester, are throw-away items from home. I will introduce project materials that will be used at the start of each unit or project and will give options for advanced work or techniques so that you can decide if there are any additional supplies that you may need. **Note:** If there is any item that you cannot obtain, please talk to your art instructor or contact Mrs. Ruth Mauk in the counseling department.
