

# A+ Recognition Scholarships

## Missouri Colleges and Universities

*Last Updated Oct.2021*

The A+ Schools Program is funded through the State of Missouri for Missouri public community colleges and vocational/technical schools ONLY.

However, some 4-year colleges in Missouri offer their own A+ recognition scholarships. **These scholarships are determined by the colleges themselves and may or may not be offered at any time.** CHECK WITH THE FINANCIAL AID OFFICE AT 4-YEAR COLLEGES AND ASK IF THEY OFFER ANY INCENTIVES FOR A+ STUDENTS.
