A+ Scholarship

Earn money for a Missouri Community College or Technical School.

Requirements:

- Turn in an A+ Application to Mrs. Forester or the Counselors Office
- Graduate with an overall unweighted GPA of 2.5 points or higher on a 4-point scale.
- Have 95% attendance record (9-12 grade)
- Score Proficient or Advanced on Algebra 1 EOC
- Complete 50 unpaid tutoring hours, up to 25% may include job shadowing
- Maintain a record of good citizenship and avoid the unlawful use of drugs/alcohol
